NCTU PE Scholarship Presentation Rules

Amended and passed by 213th Administrative Meeting on June 18, 1997
Passed by 1st Office of Academic Affairs Meeting 1986 on October 15, 1986

1. Purpose: The Rules are defined in order to enhance the PE qualities and encourage sport teams to attend external competitions to strive for honor on behalf of NCTU.
2. Counterpart: The school teams and coaches that are approved to attend the sport competitions organized by the following entities and win honors in the competitions and are held qualified under the Rules:
 - (1) Any national sport competitions organized by Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation (“CTUSF”);
 - (2) Any national college/university student sport competitions organized by the Ministry of Education.
3. Reward to sport teams: Any team or team member that attends the sport competitions identified in Article 2 herein and wins some honor may be rewarded in the following manners upon review and approval:
 - (1) Team:
 - a. The whole members of any team which wins team honor may be rewarded a scholarship. The reward will be granted based on the number of members reported to the competition board and in aggregate. The scholarship per member is granted in the following manners:
 - 1st place, NT\$3,000 per member;
 - 2nd place, NT\$2,000 per member;
 - 3rd place, NT\$1,500 per member;
 - 4th place, NT\$1,000 per member;
 - Other competition places, if any, NT\$500 per member.
 - b. In the case of more than 20 teams present, the standard reward, plus 10%;
 - In the case of more than 30 teams present, the standard reward, plus 20%;
 - In the case of more than 40 teams present, the standard reward, plus 30%;

In the case of more than 50 teams present, the standard reward, plus 50%.

- c. Where any other sport team attending the same game at the same level is found enrolling any elite student athlete, the team enrolling the elite student athlete may be excluded from the scope of reward, and the other teams' places may be promoted and apply the Rules. The other teams' places shall be promoted relatively subject to the determination of the Office of Physical Education.

(2) Team member:

- a. For track and field sports, swimming, gym or any other individual events:
Scholarship of NT\$6,000 per gold medal;
Scholarship of NT\$4,000 per silver medal;
Scholarship of NT\$3,000 per bronze medal
The scholarship for the other places will be rewarded subject to the scores. The scholarship of NT\$400 will be rewarded per score.
 - b. Double reward will be granted to members attending any relay event, which shall be shared by all of the members participating in the event evenly.
 - c. The members who receive personal reward shall not receive the team reward concurrently.
4. Reward to coaches: The scholarship shall be rewarded to the coaches of sport teams winning honor in the various competitions in the following manners:

(1) Team:

- a. 1st place, NT\$12,000;
2nd place, NT\$10,000;
3rd place, NT\$8,000;
4th place, NT\$6,000;
Other competition places, if any, NT\$3,000.

- b. In the case of:
more than 20 teams present, the standard reward, plus 10%;
more than 30 teams present, the standard reward, plus 20%;
more than 40 teams present, the standard reward, plus 30%;
more than 50 teams present, the standard reward, plus 50%

(2) Team member:

- a. For track and field sports, swimming, gym or any other individual events, the coach's scholarship shall be calculated based on the player's achievement:
Scholarship of NT\$5,000 per gold medal;
Scholarship of NT\$3,000 per silver medal;
Scholarship of NT\$2,000 per bronze medal.
The scholarship for the other places will be rewarded subject to the scores. The scholarship of NT\$400 will be rewarded per score.
 - b. The maximum scholarship shall be no more than the aggregate of the reward for 1st place in a team event and the plus thereof.
5. The application may be filed at the end of the competition and upon announcement of the player's achievement. The scholarship will be rewarded upon review of the Office of Physical Education and approval as required.
